

Announcing 2017 NPHF/Astellas Promoting Heart Health Across the Life Span Award Program

2nd Announcement-Application Deadline is February 17, 2017

The Nurse Practitioner Healthcare Foundation is proud to announce the 2017 NPHF/Astellas "Promoting Heart Health Across the Life Span" Award Program. This program provides five (5) awards of \$4000 each to Nurse Practitioner or DNP graduate students, faculty or practicing Nurse Practitioners with a clinical, research, or educational project on promoting heart health in adults, children, or older adults in the United States. **Projects focused on diverse popuations will be given special consideration.** Winners will receive an initial award of \$3000 to be used for project development and implementation and an additional \$1000 upon project completion for dissemination of outcomes through podium and/or poster presentation, journal article, etc. A Progress Report will be required by September 11, 2017 and the project must be completed by December 15, 2017.

This award is funded by a charitable donation from Astellas.

Application deadline is February 17, 2017 and the winners will be announced by March 30, 2017.
